The fundamentals of Low Stress Handling®


- 1. Start with a comfortable environment.
- 2. Keep the animal from pacing or escaping.





- 3. Support the animal well.
- 4. Move slowly to avoid the animal's resistance.
- 5. Know how to control movement in any direction.
- 6. Wait until the pet is relaxed.





- 7. Use the minimum restraint needed.
- 8. Avoid prolonged or repeated struggling.

- 9. Use distractions and rewards and distract when appropriate.
- 10. Adjust your handling based on the animal's response.
